EXPERIENCE:

It is **essential** that the post holder has:

- Considerable experience within adult's social care working with adults in a statutory social care setting including those in need of safeguarding.
- Significant experience of achieving improved outcomes for adults and carers, focusing on strength based social work approaches.
- Significant post qualifying experience.
- Demonstrable experience in supervising staff.

It is **desirable** that the post holder has:

- Demonstrable experience in change management
- Demonstrable experience of successfully managing projects.
- Practice Education Qualification

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

The County Council has developed Leadership Competencies that describe what managers in the organisation are expected to bring to their role. *(See DMA competencies document)*. Candidates for this role will be tested against these competencies and they will continue to be relevant for job performance if appointed. These competencies will be revised from time to time as the needs of the organisation change. The Critical Success Factors further describe the Leadership Competencies and for the role of Advanced Social Work Practitioner those at level 1 are relevant.

- Credibility in a significant area of specialism.
- Ability to transfer skills and lead service improvement in a variety of areas of service.

- Emotional resilience, that is, the ability to perform effectively during periods of change and stress.
